**ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, SETTING HEARING FOR TEMPORARY INUNCTION AND ORDERING A LIMITED PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS**

ALLIANCE AFT, Plaintiff in this cause, has filed a petition for a temporary injunction supported by verified evidence and, in connection therewith, has presented a request for a temporary restraining order, as set forth in its petition. The Court determines from the facts set forth in its petition & verified evidence that unless DALLAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, Defendant, is immediately ordered not to appoint the teachers selected by the Defendant's district-level advisory committee on or about June 4, 2014 (whose names were published on June 6, 2014), it will likely appoint those teachers to the home-rule school district charter commission before notice is given and a hearing is had on Plaintiff's motion for a temporary injunction; and further, that if such action by Defendant is not barred, the Plaintiff will suffer irreparable injury because the rights of Plaintiff's members to be represented on the charter commission by individuals who are selected by democratically elected representatives cannot be adequately protected and that the harm that will occur between this date and the date of a temporary injunction hearing cannot be remedied or redressed in the form of an award of damages or other remedies at law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that DALLAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, Defendant in this cause, be, and hereby is, enjoined and commanded forthwith to desist and refrain from appointing the teachers selected by the Defendant's district-level advisory committee on or about June 4, 2014 (whose names were published on June 6, 2014) to the home-rule school district charter commission from the date of entry of this order until June 27, 2014, or until further order of this Court.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition of ALLIANCE AFT, Plaintiff, for temporary injunction be heard on the 18th day of June, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., in the courtroom of the 193<sup>rd</sup> District Court in the Dallas County Courthouse in Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no later than the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2014, 5:00 p.m., the Defendant shall provide to the Plaintiff the following information with regard to the professional staff members serving on the 2013-14 District-wide Advisory Committee (DAC): all documents pertaining to the election or appointment of such individuals, including but not limited to: dates of elections, declaration of candidacy, descriptions of the candidates, lists of candidates, sample ballots,

certification of elections, documents reflecting election results, dates of appointment, appointing official, documents confirming appointment and acceptance, and documents describing the Defendant's practices for appointing or electing DAC members from various sectors, regions, feeder schools, etc.

The clerk of the above-entitled Court shall forthwith, on the filing by Plaintiff of the bond hereinafter required, and on approving the same according to the law, issue a temporary restraining order in conformity with the law and the terms of this order. This order shall not be effective unless and until Plaintiff executes and files with the clerk a bond, in conformity with the law, in the amount of \$1,000.00.
