Dr. Kyle Renard, MD, Announces Candidacy for DISD District 1

(January 28, 2015) Dallas, TX – Dallas County Schools trustee Dr. Kyle Renard, MD, announced her candidacy for the Dallas DISD District 1 position today. Dr. Renard is a board-certified pediatrician, fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, former TAG magnet high school PTSA president and Site Based Decision Making committee member who offers a unique perspective to DISD.

“Many people in the community have asked me to run because they feel that my experience as a physician offers a unique perspective when it comes to our children and education.” Renard said. “The amount of support I have received is encouraging because it is going to take all of us working together to shift the focus of DISD to putting children first.”

She is the mother of former DISD students and has seen many changes in District 1 over the last 25 years, including the transformation at Withers elementary school which was shuttered for over a decade, and is now one of the jewels in the district.
